AGREEMENT FOR INTERDISTRICT COOPERATIVE RELATED TO USE OF THERAPY POOL AT MARSHALL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

An Interdistrict Agreement has been established between the Marysville School District No. 25 ("Serving District") and Granite Falls School District No. 332 ("Resident District") related to the Granite Falls School District's request for use of the therapy pool at Marshall Elementary School during mutually agreed days and times [generally Monday – Friday from 7:30 am to 8:30 am (prior to the start of the school day)]. The purpose is to provide access for students with significant motor disabilities in the Granite Falls School District to benefit from motor therapies. The agreement outlined below establishes the provisions and obligations of each respective district.

I. General Provisions

1. The Marysville School District agrees to honor the request from the Granite Falls School District for use of the therapy pool at Marshall Elementary School during mutually agreed days and times [generally Monday – Friday from 7:30 am to 8:30 am (prior to the start of the school day)].
2. The Granite Falls School District will establish a schedule for use of the therapy pool at Marshall Elementary School, post this schedule at the school site, and provide a copy of the schedule to the special education department upon mutually agreed days and times. Granite Falls School District staff will be responsible for the supervision of students while on campus. Furthermore Granite Falls School District staff members will identify themselves as well as provide contact phone number to the Marshall Elementary School secretary.
3. If interagency coordination issues arise and, for some reason, cannot be resolved through problem resolution processes that are adopted, the Districts will provide at least 60 days notice of its intent to discontinue the interdistrict agreement.

II. District Responsibilities

1. The Marysville School District will provide access to the therapy pool during date and times mutually agreed upon and scheduled as well as provide an appropriate facility and physical space to ensure the effective delivery of therapy services to students. Marysville staff will provide training for COTA from the Granite Falls School District to test the pool chemicals for the days that Granite Falls School District staff utilizes the facility.
2. The Granite Falls School District maintains full responsibility for the supervision and safety of both students and staff from the Granite Falls School District who use the therapy pool. Granite Falls School District staff will ensure that the therapy pool is maintained and ready for use by Marysville School District staff each day.
3. All safety materials and equipment used by Granite Falls School District staff remain as property of the Marysville School District.

III. Liability Coverage Provisions

The Granite Falls School District shall provide proof of insurance as follows in the form of a Certificate of Insurance:

Commercial General Liability Insurance

Commercial General Liability insurance written on an occurrence basis with limits no less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate for personal injury, bodily injury and property damage. Coverage shall include but not be limited to: blanket contractual; products/competed operations; broad form property damage.

The Marysville School District (District) reserves the right to receive a certified copy of all required policies. The District shall be given thirty (30) days prior written notice of any calculation, suspension, and/or material change in coverage.

Indemnification/Hold Harmless

Each party shall defend, indemnify and hold the other party, its officers, officials, employees and volunteers harmless from any and all claims, injuries, damages, causes of action, losses, costs (including attorney fees), suits or judgments, arising out of injuries and damages caused by each party's own negligence.

IV. Term

This interdistrict agreement is effective beginning (DATE) July 1, 2006 and ends (DATE) June 30, 2007. This interdistrict contract may be renewed annually no later than June 1st of each year to confirm the framework for the Agreement for the following school year.

The dates of services are for approximately 180 school days during the 2006-2007 school year, with review and prospect for modification of the dates and services, if extended school year (ESY) services are approved, per each student's IEP.

V. Authorization for Interdistrict Agreement

We, the undersigned, agree to the terms of the contract for services as outlined above.
