POLICY 4016: VOLUNTEERS

The district recognizes the valuable contribution made to the total school program through the volunteer assistance of parents and other citizens. In working with volunteers, district staff shall clearly explain the volunteer's responsibility for supervising students in school, on the playground, during field trips and/or athletic events. On field trips, both students and volunteers are to be informed of the rules of student behavior and the means by which they are to be held accountable to those rules (see policy 5045, 5046).

The superintendent shall be responsible for developing and implementing procedures for the utilization of volunteers. All volunteers are required to complete the Washington State Patrol background check and provide picture identification.
