POLICY 9010: LEGAL STATUS

The corporate name of the school district is the Granite Falls School District No. 332, Snohomish County, State of Washington. The district is classified as a first-class district and is operated in accordance with the laws and regulations pertaining to the class of district.

In order to achieve its primary goal of providing each child with the necessary skills and attitudes commensurate with his/her ability to become effective citizens, the Board shall exercise the full authority granted to it by the laws of the State. Its legal powers, duties and responsibilities are derived from statute regulation. Sources such as the school code (RCW 28A), Attorney General's opinions and regulations of the State Board of Education, (WAC 180) and the Superintendent of Public Instruction (WAC 392) delineate the legal powers, duties and responsibilities of the Board of Directors.
