BOARD OF DIRECTORS

POLICY 9015: NUMBER OF MEMBERS AND TERMS OF OFFICE

The Board of Directors of the district shall consist of five members, each from a separate Director District within the school district, elected by ballot by the registered voters of the district. Except as otherwise provided by law, members of the Board shall hold office for terms of four years and until their successors are elected and qualified. Terms of school directors shall be staggered as provided by law. Newly elected directors shall take office as soon as the election results have been certified by the county auditor and the newly elected directors have taken and subscribed to an oath or affirmation that they will faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of the office to the best of their ability.
