BOARD OF DIRECTORS POLICY 9020: ELECTIONS

A School Board election shall be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November of odd-numbered years.

A person may become a candidate for a place on the Board by filing a Declaration of Candidacy with the County Auditor during the filing period as prescribed by law. In the event that there are more than two candidates for any position on the Board, a primary election shall be held in the manner prescribed by law. The two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes will appear on the school election ballot the following November.

A person is legally qualified to become a member of the Board who is a United States citizen, a qualified voter of the School District, and lives within the specified Director District area. Employees of the School District are precluded from serving on the Board of Directors.
