POLICY 9081: ADVISORY COMMITTEES

When dealing with problems affecting students and citizens, or in order to explore community opinion regarding various aspects of the school program, the Board at times may organize advisory committees to make an independent study of the problem and to bring a recommendation back to the Board. Such committees will usually include representative citizens from the district selected from lists of volunteers and staff representatives who will act as consultants and research personnel. The Board may also appoint out-of-district people who have a special expertise in the problem or subject under study.

Procedures for the conduct of the committee meetings and time schedules and other matters relating to the process by which the committee will work towards the achievement of its assignment will usually be determined at the organization meeting of the committee.

Immediately following the submittal of the final report to the Board the committee will be dissolved.
