SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Granite Falls School District Career and Technical Education (CTE) Department desires to award scholarships to graduating seniors that have excelled in the CTE programs offered at Granite Falls High School (Agriculture, Business, Health, Family and Consumer Science, Manufacturing.) The General Advisory Committee (GAC) which consists of community members will evaluate applications and award several scholarships to graduating seniors desiring to continue their training/education in preferable a program closely related to one of the above CTE programs at an accredited higher education institution. The scholarship money is to be used for tuition, books, fee, and supplies required for schooling.

Eligibility:

1. GFHS seniors who will graduate in June 2015.
2. GFHS seniors who have completed two years of CTE coursework, preferably in the same course area, where possible.

NOTE: CTE coursework includes (but is not limited to) the following classes:

- **BUSINESS:** Technology Fundamentals, Yearbook, Advanced Multimedia, Web-Graphic Design, Introduction to Business, Accounting I & II, Student Store, Entrepreneurship, Financial Fitness, Green Technology, Economics
- **FAMILY CONSUMER SCIENCE:** Independent Living, Foods for a Lifetime, Family Health, Human Development, Interpersonal Relationships.
- **MANUFACTURING:** Computer Aided Drafting and Design I and II, Intro to Manufacturing, Manufacturing II.
- **HEALTH SCIENCES:** Health Occupations.
- **AGRICULTURE:** Applied Physical Science, Applied Biology, Veterinarian Science/Horse Science, Horticulture Science.
