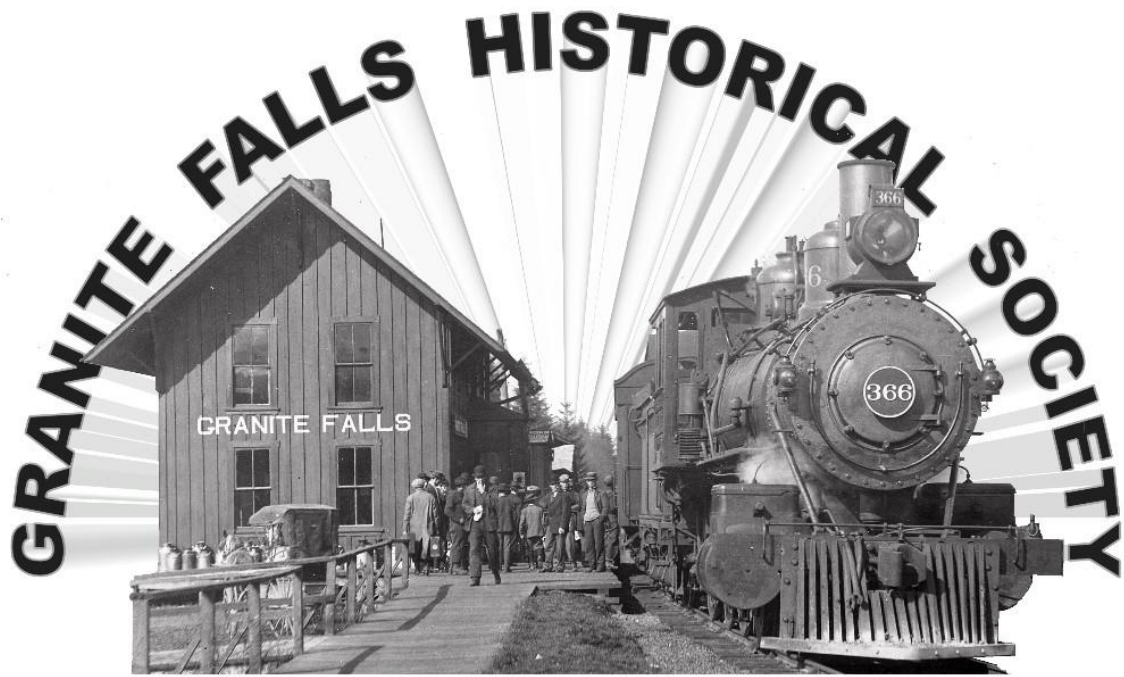

## **2015 Scholarship Application**

### **Eligibility**

The scholarship is open to all Granite Falls High School and Crossroads High School graduating seniors who plan to pursue a post-secondary degree or post-secondary college-level training for advanced technical certifications.

### **Notification**

One selected recipient will receive a \$2,000 scholarship for the purpose of tuition at a post-secondary institution. The winner will be notified by phone at least one week prior to Senior Awards Night May 21st. A voucher will be issued to the recipient at the Senior Awards Night presentation. The winner will also be recognized at the June 29<sup>th</sup> Historical Society general membership meeting at 7:00 pm. Upon enrollment in a school by the recipient, the student shall notify Tom Thorleifson at 425.314.5865 or [tthorleifson@comcast.net](mailto:tthorleifson@comcast.net) and a check will be issued directly to the school of choice in time for the ensuing school year.

### **Instructions/Selection Criteria**

Obtain application form from the Granite Falls High School Counseling Office or the Crossroads Counseling Office. Return application form and all required documents to Porscha Lachapelle in the Counseling Office on or before May 7th.

**Only completed/accurate applications received on or before the deadline will be considered.**

- Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average.
- Transcripts and HSPE (Reading & Writing)/EOC (Math & Science) test scores must be attached to the application. (SAT/ACT if available).
- A maximum 200 word essay must be submitted with the application on the following: an essay about yourself, your family, hobbies or special interests, what you have selected as your career and your long-term professional goals.
- **Two letters** of recommendation must be submitted with the application. The letters must be written by someone who has known you for at least two years (it must state in the letter how the person knows you and for how long). One letter must be from someone in a leadership role (i.e., principal, counselor, pastor, employer, etc.) Letters cannot be written by a relative.

To complete the process, a short interview may be held with selected students on-site at Granite Falls High School or Crossroads High School.
