As part of our work to improve student achievement, Monte Cristo and Mountain Way Elementary Schools are offering FREE tutoring to income eligible students this year! Under the federal No Child Left Behind Act, families who qualify for the free and reduced meal services are eligible to receive this service. We will be offering two enrollment windows: **September 16 through October 2** and **November 9 through November 25**.

If you are interested in receiving free tutoring for your child, **please complete and return the participation form by October 2, 2015 for the first enrollment period.** Once all of the letters are returned at the end of the enrollment window, we will use the most current student scores to determine who will receive the services. Since the funding is limited, you will receive a letter from the district if your child is selected to receive the tutoring services.

You can choose a free tutoring program that best meets your child's needs from the list of approved tutoring programs in your area. A spreadsheet with details about the providers is available here including programs that meet the needs of English language learners or students with special needs.
