INSTRUCTION

POLICY 6000: HOME BASED INSTRUCTION

The Granite Falls School District recognizes the right of parents to elect to educate their children at home. The District shall cooperate with the parents of home-based students by assisting them in complying with legal requirements and by making available appropriate experiences for such students. The District reserves the right of final determination as to the appropriate level of placement for students wishing to enroll who have been receiving home-based instruction. Home-based students wishing to receive a high school diploma shall comply with district policy and procedures relating to high school graduation requirements.

The Granite Falls School District shall also permit the enrollment of and provide ancillary services for part-time students, in compliance with state law and regulations.

The Superintendent shall establish procedures that specify district rules relating to home based and part –time students.
