Beginning in 2020, **all students** enrolled in the **Granite Falls School District** can use their student ID number to:

- Check-out **10 physical items** at any library location
- Download **20 digital items** (eBooks and eAudiobooks)
- Access **online homework help** and **streaming content**
- Use computers with filtered **internet access** at any library



Why is a student account important?

The purpose of a student account is:

- to continue building **strong partnerships** between Sno-Isle Libraries and the Granite Falls School District;
- to better **enable educators** to use library resources in the classroom;
- to provide **equitable library access** for all students.

What does this mean for my student?

- Students will **automatically receive access** unless parents or guardians choose to opt-out.
- There will be **no fines**.
- This program is **in compliance** with the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
- Students who already have a Sno-Isle Libraries card can continue to **use it in addition** to their student account.
