It is our sincere hope, if you choose to complete the Local Scholarship Application, that you will attend **Scholarship and Awards Night on May 29, 2025.**

Check off each step to make sure your application is complete by the application deadline.

Step 1: Complete the Local Scholarship Application by using the fillable PDF online. The online application is available at the Granite Falls High School Website by clicking on the Counseling Tab and scrolling down to Scholarships or by going in to the Senior Hub (for GFHS students).

Step 2 (on page 3): Mark with an "X" all scholarships you wish to apply for.

Step 3 (on pages 14 - 16): Request Letters of Recommendation from teachers and community members/extra-curricular activities two weeks before the deadline. **Request by March 20, 2025.**

Step 4 (on page 17) : Request a copy of your transcript one week before the deadline. The Transcript Request form is in the Local Scholarship Application. **Request by March 28, 2025.**

Step 5: Once your application is complete print all documents, **SINGLE SIDED**, including your resume and transcript. Bring all forms to the Counseling Center. Forms will be scanned and returned along with a binder. Note: The PDF is a fillable form.

□ Step 6: Turn in your completed application binders to the Counseling Department by April 10, 2025 at
2:00 p.m. Late applications will be noted on the bottom of the application.

Step 7: GFHS students, applications will be uploaded when scanned in by Counseling Center. Crossroads students, email your completed applications to <u>amyers@gfalls.wednet.edu</u> Resume and transcript must be submitted as part of your uploaded file.
