**Step 5:** Your completed application must be placed in binders with page protectors which will be provided by the Counseling Department. **You will need 1 copy and one electronic copy of your complete scholarship application. Be sure to attach a copy of your resume.**

**Step 6:** Turn in your completed application binders to the Counseling Department by **April 11, 2024 at 2:00 p.m.** **Late applications will be noted on the bottom of the application.**

**Step 7:** GFHS students to upload your completed application electronically to Senior Hub. Crossroads students, email your completed applications to [amyers@gfalls.wednet.edu](mailto:amyers@gfalls.wednet.edu) Resume and transcript must be submitted as part of your uploaded file.
