Next Step: Review your Transcript

Be sure to check and if they are bringing down your GPA, see Jordan in the Counseling Office to get the form needed to remove those grades.

What about failed classes?

- Be sure to sign up for classes you need to retake!
- Sign up NOW for Credit Retrieval (Summer School). It is free and will be from June 23rd until July 2nd. Sign up NOW if its needed. Must have a 40% or better to do face to face Credit Retrieval. Some spaces in Edgenuity may be available. See counselor.
- Could retrieve credit in Eng 9/10 and Alg/Geo if you pass SBA in English and Math.
- Self Pay for online classes (BYU)- approx. \$100-\$200 each
- Fluent in another language? You could earn credits by taking the World Lang test. See counselor.
- Meet with your counselor to create grad plan

After viewing your Grad Requirements...

Make note of the classes you need. If you are a Junior, make sure you have accounted for all required classes!

- On your registration form write in your *post high school plan* and *diploma type*.
- Current 9-11 write in your Personalized Pathway courses

How to choose your classes:

Think about...



- Do you have a CTE pathway for graduation?
- What are you interested in?
- What classes do you need for graduation?
- Do you need to retake a failed class?
- What other activities do you participate in? Sports, clubs, volunteering, job, family commitments? Make sure you are balancing these with the rigor of your courses.

- We want you to be challenged, but not overwhelmed!
- Choose classes carefully– changes most likely won't be allowed!

CONSTRUCTION FOUNDATIONS

Construction Foundations prepares students to apply technical knowledge, skills, and abilities working as a team member to complete projects. Instruction will include development of a work plan, print reading, construction measurement and lay out, construction processes, tools and equipment, and safety. You must have taken and passed Intro to Construction to be enrolled in this class.

INTRODUCTION TO CAD

This course gives you hands-on experience using hightech tools like laser cutter/engraver, CNC machines, and 3D printers to bring your ideas to life. You will learn how to use computer software to design and create 2D and 3D models for engineering projects and using design skills to solve real world problems. Whether it's designing parts, creating signage, or using Computer-Aided Design (CAD) software, this class will help you develop the skills to turn your creative ideas into real-world designs.

Core Classes

- We will now go over your English, History, Science, and Math options.
- Refer to the Course Catalog and Course Offering Sheet(pg 32-34) to choose your Electives and Alternates.
- Input all of your Requests and Alternates into Skyward. You must log on as a student, not as a parent.
- Input your requests by March 20th ! Please be sure courses and alternates are input in to Skyward ASAP!

Class requirements -English Choices

1st Choose your English Class

12th- English 4 or AP Lit or Foundational Eng 4

11th English 3 or AP Lang or Foundational Eng 3

10th English 2 or Pre-AP English 2 or

Foundational Eng 2

To take Pre AP or AP, get your English teacher's approval . You have already been signed up for regular English.. If you want AP, just add it and I will go back and delete the regular English class.



Class Requirements-History Choices

 2nd Choose your History Class
 12th- Must take Amer Civics/CWP OR AP Psych OR CITHS/AP Gov.
 11th US History or CITHS/AP US History
 10th World History or CITHS/AP World History

Remember, CITHS classes are college level classes and equal more work AND some are worth additional credit.

All 10th and 11th graders were signed up for regular history. If you want AP, just add it and I will delete the regular history class.



Class Requirements-Science Choices

- 3rd Choose your Science Class
 12th Consider additional year of science (Physics or Chem, etc)
 - 11th Same as below PLUS CITHS Chemistry, Physics, Biomed, AgroEcology, Marine biology
 - 10th Conceptual Biology, Animal Bio, Plant Bio, Vet, etc



Class Requirements-Math Choices

- 4th Choose your Math Class
 - See your math teacher for math recommendation.
 - Typical sequence is: Alg 1, Geometry, and then Alg 2 or 3rd credit of math based on PPR. Juniors may need to wait until 12th grade to access Financial Fitness.
 - Remember a math-based class (CITHS precalc, CITHS chem, physics, fin fit etc) is required in Sr year for 4 year college bound students! The more math you take the better!



Other requirements and your ELECTIVES

- Are you on track with PE, Art, CTE, and Health?
- Do you have your 2 years or more of Spanish and a math based class for Senior year if doing a 4 year college?
- Do you need to retake a failed class?
- What are your Personalized Pathway Classes?
- All Seniors are strongly encouraged to take Financial Fitness as this will help you with Sr Presentations and life after High School.
- Note: Band is no longer offered zero period. Please disregard that option.

Schedule

- Request Courses for 2025-2026 in GRANITE FALLS HIGH SCHOOL
- Log on to Skyward as a STUDENT and Click "Schedule" on the far left side.
- In the top right section of the screen, click "Request courses for 2025-2026 in Granite Falls High School "
- In the search bar on the lower left side of the screen type the course code from the course offerings sheet ("ENG" for English, "HIS" for History, "MAT" for Math, etc.)
 - Note: we have already added in some classes for you.. If you want something different just add it and we will delete the class you do not want. For example, if you want AP US History instead of regular US History, we will drop US.
- When you see the correct code and course title that you want in "Selected Courses", click on the course and then click "Add Course"
- Be sure to add BOTH semesters for a course if it is a year-long course (if Skyward doesn't do it automatically)
- Skyward will tell you how many classes to request AND then enter at least 4 alternates in case your first choice is not available. When you are done, just close out... your choices will be saved.

Timelines and Important info

- You must enter your requests <u>and</u> alternates on Skyward! See page 34 for directions.
- If you do not register, classes will be selected for you and you will not be able to change your schedule.
- Courses are offered based on what YOU register for so take this seriously.
- INPUT REQUESTS in SKYWARD BY March 20th. Turn form in to History teacher/Freshman Success teacher this day

What's Next?

- See your counselor or ask teacher if you need advice on what to take
- Remember, If you do not sign up for classes, classes will be chosen for you.
- Reminder: Choose your classes AND your alternates carefully! Our schedule will be tight next year and changes may not be allowed.



Important: Don't forget alternates

- Once you have entered in 6 classes, click on the top tab marked "View Alternates"
- Add 4 alternates using the same process you used to select classes.
- If an alternate is a yearlong class, request the first semester only.
- Alternates are very important! We use these if a class you requested does not run due to insufficient sign-ups or if it conflicts with another class you requested that is only offered once. It is EVEN MORE important this year to have alternates chosen.
- If you do not provide alternates and one of your requested classes is not available, <u>your counselor</u> <u>will have to choose for you.</u>

LAST STEP: DOUBLE CHECK!

- Did you enter in the required number of requests?
- Do you have 4 alternates listed? In your preferred order?
- Do your choices help you meet graduation requirements?
- Do your choices keep your options open after high school?
- When you are done, just exit out or save it as a pdf.
